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Strategic Plan

- The APGNN action plan aimed at increasing APGNN membership acquisition, engagement, and retention
 - Increasing APGNN collegiality with NASPGHAN and CPNP
 - Continued creation of educational offerings to our members
 - Promote improved engagement and longevity of our members
 - Mentoring program



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Overall Outcomes

- We have increased our rate of new membership applications significantly since the annual meeting through the following initiatives:
 - Buy 3 Get One Free-intended for NASPGHAN members and institutions that support their nurse's membership
 - APGNN Membership Booth at NASPGHAN-space complimentary from NASPGHAN
 - Handbook of Pediatric Gastroenterology 2nd ed. Currently sold out! Actively working on 3rd ed.



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Overall Outcomes

- Our organization successfully negotiated a membership agreement between APGNN and NAPNAP (National Association of Pediatric Nurse Practitioners) in 2016.
 - The agreement allows members to join both organizations and receive a 20% discount as a result of dual membership.
 - New CEU provider to help streamline the CE evaluation process
 - We will have 1 module soon for CE offering - FPIES
 - We are taping our sessions for this conference and modules will be available for purchase – hopefully 1st quarter 2019
 - BA module is up and running...AND FANTASTIC



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Overall Outcomes

- APGNN does not have the member numbers or resources to pursue formal certification at present
 - Numerous other options to improve engagement and advancement do exist and will be explored in the near future
 - Badging, competency creation, learning bundles have been pursued
 - We will be pursuing learning modules which will initially be for new to GI nurses, then expand to all members



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Challenges

- Our infrastructure and lack of formal structured administrative support has made budgeting difficult.
- Technology challenges in relation to website support and features
- All volunteer board, it is often difficult to move projects and initiatives forward due to limited resources both financial and human.

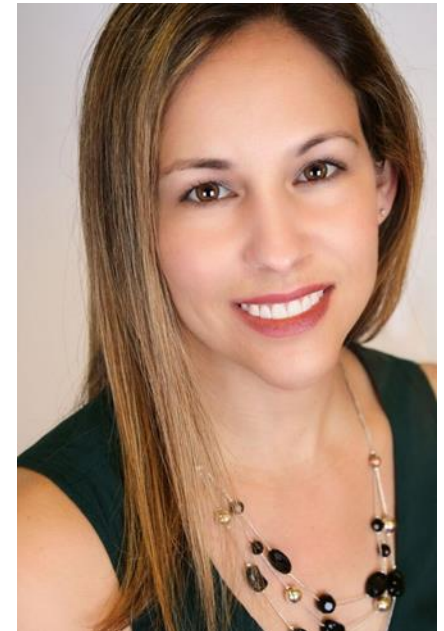

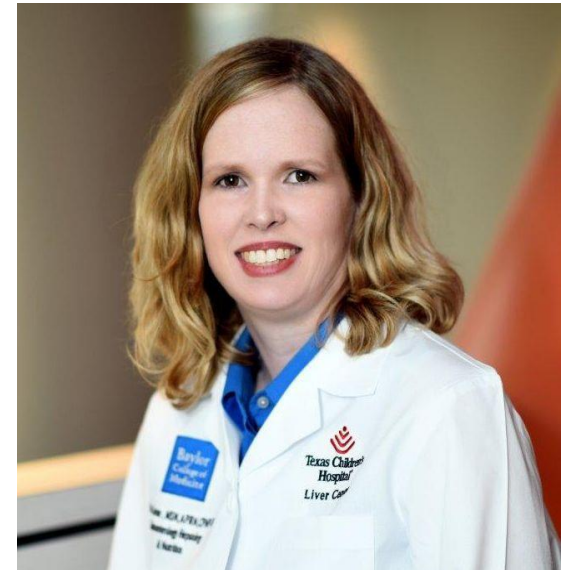
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Clinical Practice Committee
