Deadline for Submission: August 1, 2021

Purpose

- This award is established to acknowledge and honor APGNN members in good standing that excel in the care of Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition patients.

Eligibility

- Has been an APGNN member during the past 36 months

Submission Criteria

- All nominations must include:
 - Letter (1-2 page, typed, approximately 250 words) nomination that enumerates the ways in which the APGNN member reflects the purpose of the award; fostering practice, teaching and/or advocacy
 - Curriculum vitae of nominee
 - APGNN nominator's name, professional credentials and contact information

Award Process

- Award to be selected by members of the APGNN Executive Board and coordinated by the Membership Committee Chairperson. The recipient will be awarded a commemorative plaque and a check in the sum of \$250.00 during the annual APGNN meeting. The award will be presented by his/her nominating APGNN member.

Criteria Used in Evaluating Nominees

- The nominee must have the following qualities:
 - Provides excellent model of professionalism
 - Has expanded the role of nursing in gastroenterology, hepatology, and nutrition
 - Assists nursing colleagues in professional development. Actively guides and assists with clinical work, research and/or education; articulates and encourages high standards
 - Accessible for advice and assistance as a mentor for those new to the specialty and takes time to ensure guidance is provided
 - Is actively involved as an APGNN member in clinical, educational and/or research activities
 - Assists in overcoming problems or barriers to ongoing professional development
 - Collaborates with other disciplines
